UASC must comply with certain federal, state, & local guidelines and must work with the Union Arena Community Center to ensure the safety of our skaters, coaches & community. We ask for your help in following those guidelines. UASC has the right to change & modify these guidelines when appropriate due to the fluidity situation with Covid-19. UASC COVID-19 Policies & Guidelines provided will outline safety while in the Union Arena & attending UASC lessons. UASC had a successful & safe summer skating session & we are hopeful with everyone's help to continue that trend through the winter & spring skating seasons. Please take a moment to read the information below & help everyone have a safe & enjoyable skating experience.

General Safety Guidelines:

- Masks must be worn while entering, exiting, and while inside the building, including on the ice.
- Six feet social distancing while entering, exiting and while inside the building, including on the ice whenever possible.
- Public hand sanitizing stations will be provided by the rink in convenient and strategic locations
- Rink exterior doors will be locked until a group is permitted inside, no more than 10 minutes before the scheduled ice time.
- Skaters must arrive at rink ready to take the ice (ie dressed, skates on, etc.)
- Lobby bathrooms will be limited to two occupants at one time. Only those permitted in the building will have access, they are not available to the public.
- Spectators are not allowed in the facility at this time (including parents/guardians).
- No use of public drinking fountains, or access to water.
- Skaters will enter the ice through the "public skating" door. Boxes and benches will be off limits to all skaters.

Guidelines for Parents & Skaters:

- Please do not come to skating if you are experiencing any of the symptoms associated with Covid-19 infection (including elevated temperature, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, etc.)
- UASC requires skaters & parents to complete a Covid-19 waiver before skaters may take the ice.
- All skaters entering the building will need to complete a wellness screening for Union Arena & UASC including taking temperature & Screening Certificate.
- Skaters may not participate if they (or any household members) have been outside New England or red/yellow counties without quarantining for 14 days or 7 days with a negative Covid-19 test following The State of Vermont travel guidelines.

- In the event any UASC skater tests positive for Covid-19 or finds they were exposed to someone with Covid-19 within 14 days of attending any skating session skater or parent/guardian shall inform UASC President Kristiana Ploss at uaskateclub@gmail.com immediately.
